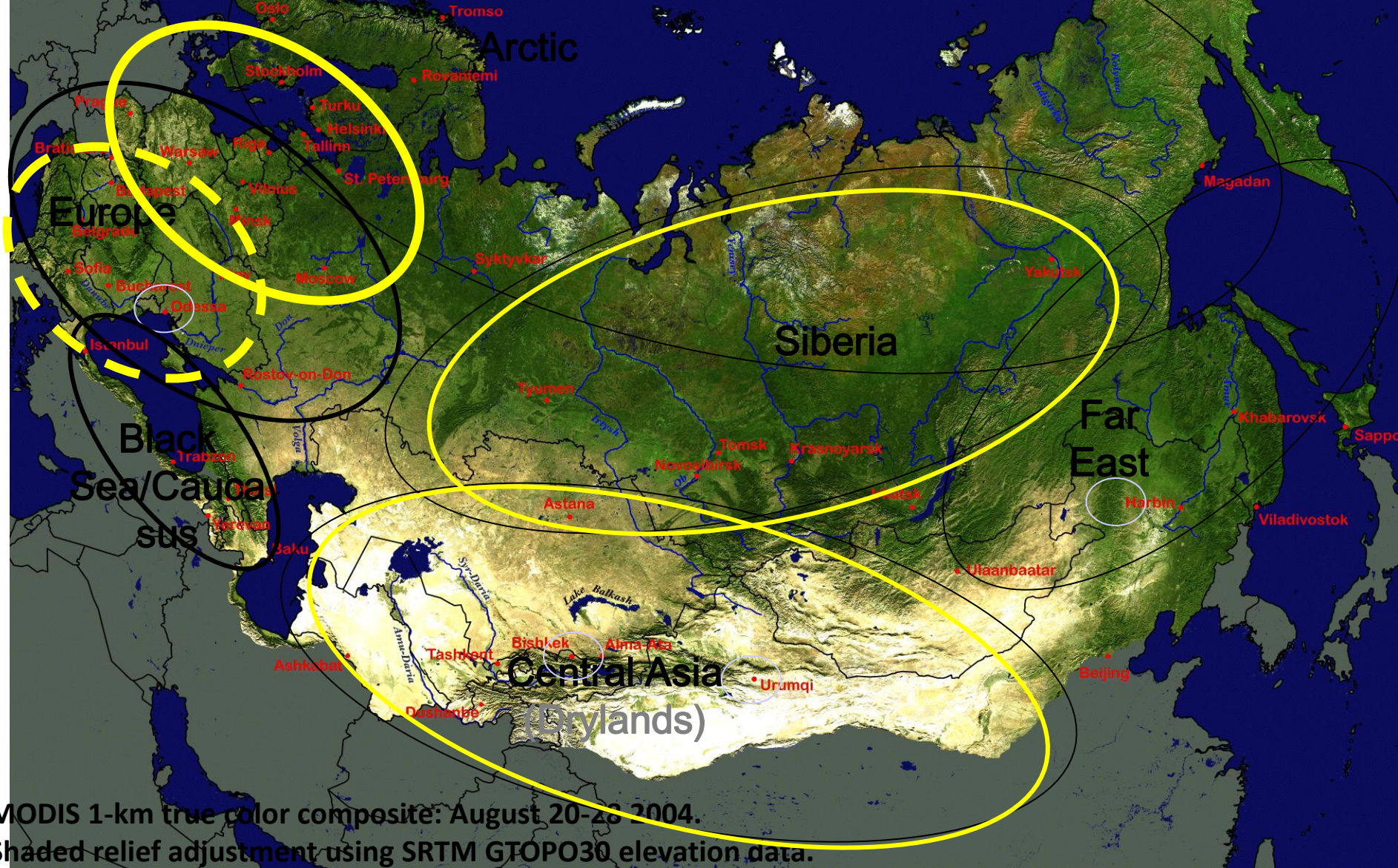
# LCLUC/NEESPI/GOFC-GOLD
